School Information

School Lunches - September 2018

Our new lunch menu for September is now live on the meals website. A copy of the menu and upcoming 'Theme Days' has been sent out by Parentmail. The first seven weeks of term are available on the website, so you can order well in advance. Our first Theme Day Lunch, a 'World Space Week' lunch is on Thursday 4th October. **Tuesday 28th August is the deadline for ordering meals for the first two days back (Thursday 6th & Friday 7th September). Please ensure you do not miss this!** All orders, including Universal Infant Free School Meals (Rec - Year 2) and those with an entitlement to free school meals, **must** be placed before this deadline - the kitchen is **not able** to accommodate for any unordered meals.

When you next log in to your account, you will be asked to change your child's class to the one they will move up to in September - please ensure this is correct to avoid any issues when we return to school. All other account details will remain the same. If you have a sibling starting in nursery or Reception in September, you can add them to your existing account. For pupils who pay for their lunches the cost of 5 lunches a week will increase to £11.00. This is due to an increase in staffing and ingredient costs. The individual daily cost will remain at £2.30
