samsara	Birth, life, death, reincarnation.
moksha	Circle of life.
	Aum symbol. This is the sacred symbol and mantra of Brahman.
creation	Action or process of bringing something into existence.
Trimurti	The triad of three main gods in Hinduism.
ceremony	A formal religious or public occasion.
temple	A building that is devoted to the worship of god or gods.
