Proposed No Waiting At Any Time

We have received a letter from Lincolnshire County Council regarding a proposed review of the waiting restrictions in the vicinity of our school. Their investigations have shown that there is regular inconsiderate and dangerous parking occurring at the junctions close to the school causing safety concerns for all children and road users.

We have been monitoring the parking close to the school site and taking photographs to send to the council as part of our feedback and will continue to do this in the next few weeks. While we do not want to make it harder for parents to park close to the school, it is imperative that the safety of our children and their families is at the forefront of our response.

Sports Report from Mrs Anderson

Thankfully the weather was perfect on Tuesday and 20 boys from Year 5 and 6 were able to participate in an Elite Sports football competition held at West Pinchbeck playing fields. There were schools from Spalding, The Deepings, Crowland and Peterborough. It was a great day of football, and all the boys supported each other, showing teamwork and determination throughout the event.
