IMPORTANT - School Lunch Orders

If your child is in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2 they are entitled to Universal Free School Meals. Historically our school lunch ordering system would automatically order a pasta pot if you had not ordered for your child. Unfortunately, with our new system this is now no longer possible.

If you want your child to have a school lunch, please ensure you have logged in and placed your order by Tuesday of the week before. Alternatively, you can send your child to school with a packed lunch. Thank you.

Final Reminder - Children Starting School in September 2026

The application process is now open. If you have a child who was born between 1st September 2021 and 31st August 2022, the deadline for making your application is 15th January 2026. Places will be offered to parents on 16th April 2026.

Parking

Despite numerous messages and two near misses at the end of last term, we continue to receive concerns regarding the manner of parking and driving around our school site at drop off and collection times. Today we have been sent photographs of cars abandoned half on the path/half on the road on Westbourne Park. If you are driving to school to drop off/collect children, please park considerately. The zigzag lines outside the school are there to ensure our children are able to get to school safely. **Stopping or parking on the zigzag yellow lines is not permitted from 8:00-9:00am and from 3:00-4:00pm.** If you park in these areas, children have a restricted view when they are trying to cross the road safely - yesterday morning, a child was almost knocked over by a car in front of the school. Please do not park on the entry or exit roads to the school or on any side roads where your parking causes an obstruction to local residents.
