Please note the following:

- Children will be registered at the start of the club; therefore, if for any reason your child cannot attend on the day of the club, please let us know.
- All clubs finish at 4:00pm prompt. Please ensure that your children are collected on time at the end of the club. The location of all pick up points from clubs is highlighted on your child's acceptance slips.
- After the February half term break, children in Y5/6 will be permitted to walk home on their own, only if you have provided us with a permission slip – until this point they must be collected by an adult.
- There is no access to the school car park to collect children from after school clubs.

IMPORTANT - Reception Places - September 2024

The application process to apply for Reception places for 2024-25 opened on 15th November. This applies to all children who were born between 1st September 2019 and 31st August 2020.
