### Clubs (Years 1-6)

Please note the following:

- Children will be registered at the start of the club; therefore, if for any reason your child cannot attend on the day of the club, please let us know.
- All clubs finish at 4:00pm prompt (Coding & Monday Netball 4:15pm). Please ensure that your children are collected on time at the end of the club. The location of all pick up points from clubs is highlighted on your child's acceptance slips.

- After the February half term break, children in Y5/6 will be permitted to walk home on their own, **only** if you have provided us with a permission slip - until this point they must be collected by an adult.
- There is no access to the school car park to collect children from after school clubs.

Confirmations have not been sent out for Cross Country as this can be attended by any children in Years 3-6.

Clubs begin next week (week commencing 19<sup>th</sup> January) and will run until 27<sup>th</sup> March. Please note that there will be no school led club's week commencing 9<sup>th</sup> February (due to Parents' Evenings); external clubs will run as normal.
