February Parents' Evening - **Please note the arrangements for separated families**

As previously advertised in our calendar dates, parents' evenings will be held on Wednesday 7th and Thursday 8th February. Notification to book appointments was sent to all parents earlier this week and all bookings must be made via the Parentmail online booking system. Once an appointment is made, the system will allow you to change your appointment, **please note this is subject to the availability of appointments.**

Separated Families - Please book only one appointment per child. We are aware that many of our children have separated families and historically, we accommodated two appointments for these children. However, this meant that the teachers had to increase the number of appointments which makes it unmanageable over two nights and they were having to repeat the same information twice. Sharing the information once ensures a clear and consistent message to both parents. Therefore, please either attend one appointment together or agree to share the information given after the appointment. In some **extreme cases (where court orders/proceedings are in place)** we understand that this may not be possible and we would ask that you call the school office to discuss this.

Parents will be allocated one 10-minute appointment for each child. If your child is on the SEND register, the system has been created to allow you to book a 20-minute appointment in line with our school policy. If you would like an appointment to meet with Mrs Humphreys, Mrs Arnold or Mrs Coles, in addition to your meeting with your child's class teacher, please contact Miss Le via the school office. Mrs Arnold and Mrs Coles will only be available for this on the Wednesday.
