Terms 1 & 2 After School Clubs (school led)

School led clubs will start next week (week commencing Monday 19th September). Club slips were sent via Parentmail this week, informing parents of which club children have been allocated. Please check the slip carefully as NOT ALL clubs finish at 4:00pm - the slip will also confirm the collection location. The final week of clubs is week commencing Monday 28th November - please make a note of this on your calendar.

Sports Clubs - The response to sports clubs for Term 1 and 2 has been very high. It has therefore been necessary to put a cap on the number of children attending depending upon the club, age of pupils and the space. If your child does not get a place in their chosen club this term, we will retain their details and

give them priority if they sign up for a club in terms 3 and 4. Children in Key Stage 2 will also have an opportunity to join in lunchtime clubs. The first clubs will be football for boys and girls to allow teams to be sorted for upcoming events.

<u>PERMISSION TO WALK HOME AFTER CLUBS</u> - Year 5 and Year 6 children require permission to walk home from clubs up to October half term. ALL children must be collected from after school clubs from term 2 due to the darker evenings.

Year 3-6 Cross Country

If your child (Years 3-6) would like to join before school cross-country, (Terms 1-6) they should meet Mrs Anderson (Monday) and Miss McRae (Friday) on the field at 8:15am via the Kingsley Avenue gate. If your child (Years 1-2) would like to join before school cross-country, (Terms 1-6) they should meet Mrs Binns (Thursday) on the field at 8:15am via the Kingsley Avenue gate. Children should come in their running kit and bring school uniform to change in to. Please do not drop children at school for morning cross-country when it is raining heavily as the gates will remain locked.

Oracy Challenge - Reflecting on how we feel



Bourne Heritage Weekend

As part of Bourne Heritage open days, Wake House on North Street will be opening this weekend 17th and 18th September. Wake House was the birthplace of Charles Worth, who became the 'Father of Haute Couture'. Find out about the historic fashion industry and the building and how it now benefits local people. Wake House will be open on both days from 10.30am-4pm and admission is free.

Our children learnt about Charles Worth as part of Arts Week in 2021 and some of this work will form part of the exhibition. The show piece is a felted replica of Charles Worth's famous 'peacock dress' which every child in the school contributed to.

Willoughby Memorial Trust Art Gallery (Corby Glen) Open Art Competition 2022

Willoughby memorial Trust in Corby Glen are opening their doors again this year to children in Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 who would like to enter their art work into the 2022 Open Art Competition. The exhibition will be shown from 2^{nd} November to 25^{th} November 2022.

Work will be entered into two categories, KS1 or KS2 and there are cash prizes available for pieces of work chosen by the panel of judges. Work can be in 2D or 3D but must not exceed 914x914 in size.
