Atkinson's Announcements

Parking

We have continued to receive a number of concerns this week regarding the manner of parking and driving around our school site at drop off and collection times. If you are driving to school to drop off/collect children please park considerately. The zigzag lines outside the school are there to ensure our children are able to get to school safely. Stopping or parking on the zigzag yellow lines is not permitted from 8:00-9:00am and from 3:00-4:00pm. If you park in these areas, children have a restricted view when they are trying to cross the road safely - this morning, a child was almost knocked over by a car in front of the school. Please do not park on the entry or exit roads to the school or on any side roads where your parking causes an obstruction to local residents. If one of our neighbours does speak to you about where you have parked, please be polite to them.

Please note that it is illegal to sit in your car with the engine running when stationary. Section 42 of the Road Traffic Act 1988 prohibits leaving your engine on when it is not needed and fines can be issued.
