Ofsted and Drains

Thank you to all of you who responded to the Ofsted survey on Monday. The Ofsted team were unable to come due to the school closure, but they will of course be back at some point to inspect the school. I would ask that as many parents as possible complete the parent survey to support the school during inspection. The responses to the question regarding personal development were mixed. I will be sending out a summary of the school's personal development strategy, 'A Star is Bourne', so that you can see what the school does to support pupil's personal development. We see this as a real strength of the school and hope you do too. We were disappointed not to get the inspection out of the way before half term as we were ready for the visit and wanting to share all the fabulous things we do here at Westfield.

I appreciate the support and understanding regarding the drains and wanted to clarify that the blockage was not on the school site and was out of our control. Our site staff regularly clear our drains and check for blockages – we are currently checking the drains on our site at least twice a day. We have invested in a water bowser this week to help aid this process, but we cannot clear the drains on Kingsley Avenue. We are hoping that Anglian Water will be descaling the pipes soon to help stop this happening again. We did investigate portable toilets, but these would have been over £6,000 and would have required high levels of staffing to ensure they were used safely. We hope Anglian Water will resolve the scaling soon to ensure we do not have to close for this issue in the future.
