### Sports Report from Mrs Anderson

Both of our teams were entered in the competitive competition, which consisted of 6 teams playing each other, in a round robin format. At the end of the matches, 3 schools were on equal points having all won 4 out of their 5 matches. Goal difference was therefore used to place the top 3, Westfield 'A' team came home with the trophy with a goal difference of 24 and our B team were pipped to the silver medal position by Langtoft 'A' team with a goal difference of 14 to their 12.

Well done to all our players who played with such good sporting values; their teamwork, determination, fair play alongside such fantastic netball skills made Mrs Anderson, Miss Hall and Mrs Knowles very proud. They were a credit to Westfield and the Westy Way!
