Sports Report from Mrs Anderson

As it finally stopped raining, we were able to take a squad of 24 pupils from KS2 to take part in a cross-country event run by Ayscoughfee Hall Prep school. We competed in 4 events against 5 other private schools. We performed well in all the races, competing against a very strong field with two pupils receiving medals for their individual places. In the overall team events, in which the top 4 runners scores are added together to create a team score, we did exceptionally well coming 2^{nd} in the Year 3/4 boys, 3^{rd} in the Year 3/4 girls, 3^{rd} for the Year 5/6 girls and 4^{th} by just 1 point in the Year 5/6 boys' team.

These results show that we had a strong squad who were able to compete competitively against a very experienced opposition. A huge thank you to all the parents who came along to help with the event. KS2 (Years 3-6) cross country club is on Monday mornings at 8.15am every week that school led clubs are on, please come along and have a go, no need to sign up just turn up.

Today, we have had a cricket inspiration day for children in Years 2 and year 3. Next week Year 1 and Year 4 children will have sessions.
