Atkinson's Reminders

Parking

We have noticed a number of cars regularly parked on the single yellow lines on the entrance road to our car park. We would like to remind you of the following from The Highway Code -

Rule 238 - You **MUST NOT** wait or park on yellow lines during the times of operation shown on nearby time plates (or zone entry signs if in a Controlled Parking Zone).

Rule 243 - **DO NOT** stop or park:

- near a school entrance
- anywhere you would prevent access for Emergency Services
- opposite or within 10 metres (32 feet) of a junction, except in an authorised parking space

This is to allow drivers emerging from, or turning into, the junction a clear view of the road they are joining. It also allows them to see hazards such as pedestrians or cyclists at the junction.

Please do not use this area for parking or waiting during the hours of 8-9am and 3-4pm (unless you have a valid blue badge). Currently the cars are parking close to the junction which inhibits any other vehicles from entering the road on the correct side of the road.

School Uniform Reminder

While walking around school, I've noticed that some children are wearing slight variations of our summer school uniform. Children are able to wear our winter uniform all year round with the summer variations in bold. Please check the table below for details about our summer uniform.

 Summer Variation - in bold (Start of Term 5 - end of Term 1)
white short-sleeve shirt or reverse collar blouse emerald green polo shirt
navy & green striped tie (must be worn with a collared shirt)
<u>v-neck</u> sweatshirt or cardigan with school emblem
grey long or short trousers grey skirt or pinafore dress emerald green check dress (no play suits)
grey or white socks or grey or navy tights (no brand logos)
black shoes (no sandals or trainers)
