REMINDER - Medicines in School

We have had some instances since the beginning of this term where medication has been brought into school by a child. A courtesy reminder that all medicines **MUST** be brought to the school office by an adult and the appropriate form completed. All medicines will then be available for collection from the classroom - we will not send any medication home with a child. We are only able to administer medicines that have been prescribed **4 times per day** in line with our Trust policy.

Clubs

Terms 1 & 2 After School Clubs (school led only)

School led clubs will start next week (week commencing **Monday 21st September**). I am sure you will join me in thanking staff for running our after-school clubs this year. Club slips have been sent via MCAS informing parents of which club, children have been allocated. All school led clubs end on **Friday 27th November** - please make a note of this on your calendar. Please note the following:

- Children will be registered at the start of the club; therefore, if for any reason your child cannot attend on the day of the club **please let us know**.
- Please ensure that your children are collected on time at the end of the club - please check the confirmation for the end time of your child's club. **The location of all pick up points from clubs is highlighted on the map information sent out.**
- **PERMISSION TO WALK HOME AFTER CLUBS** - Year 5 and Year 6 children **must have permission** to walk home from clubs until October half term if they are not being collected. After the October half term break, **ALL** children must be collected from after school clubs due to the darker evenings.
- There is no access to the school car park to collect children from after school clubs.
- There will be no school led clubs in the week where parents' evening is held - week commencing 19th October.

A few parents have asked about before school cross country. This will begin in the Spring term - more information will be shared nearer the time.
