Well done to all our amazing Year 6 pupils who have taken their SATs this week. We are so very proud of how hard they have worked and conducted themselves during the tests! They have shown what a fantastic year group they are and we hope they enjoyed their special treat this afternoon.

## Sports Report from Mrs Anderson

The last couple of weeks have been busy with lots of activities both at school and outside of school. The introduction of Sports Star of the Day in PE lessons has had a positive impact, as children are rewarded for showing various attributes: determination, improvement of skills/progression and teamwork in lessons. School sports clubs have gone from strength to strength and the Year 6 sports leaders are setting up multi-skills clubs at lunchtime in KS2. We are also seeing many children come to tennis club at lunchtime on a roll up basis. It is great to watch them having fun and improving their tennis skills in their own time.

Last week we sent 20 Year 3 pupils to a fun rugby festival, run by Agilitas Sports as part of the school games, at Spalding Grammar School. The pupils had some coaching in the morning to learn some of the basic skills and played some mini tag rugby games in the afternoon. It was a great day, with lots of positive outcomes, learning new skills and meeting people from other local primary schools. For many of the pupils, it was their first time representing the school, so well done! If you are keen to play rugby, Bourne Rugby Club are always keen to get new players.

On Wednesday we took 16 pupils from Year 5 to play in a competitive Dynamos cricket competition at Market Deeping cricket club. We had 2 teams the Sharks and the Warriors. As the day progressed both teams really got the cricket bug and improved in all areas, showing some fantastic batting, teamwork and fielding. The Warriors, lost 2 games (drew 1 and won 1), coming 3rd overall whilst the Sharks only lost 1 game to the winners of the tournament, coming 2nd overall. This was especially impressive as they went down to 7 players when fielding due to an injury. Well done to all the pupils involved, you represented Westfield beautifully.
