It has been yet another busy active week at Westfield. Firstly, all pupils have taken part in an obstacle run in their PE lessons to highlight the importance of being active to help our physical and mental health. It was great to see them all enjoying this activity and understanding the importance of being active every day.

On Tuesday it was the turn of the year 6 cricket teams to take part in the annual inter school competition, run by Agilitas Sports as part of our School Games calendar. The sun shone and both teams put in fantastic performances throughout the day. For many of the children, it was their first experience of a cricket match and for some it was their first-time representing Westfield at a sporting event. All pupils made great individual progress, using the skills we have been focusing on this term. The competition was tough with both teams playing 5 matches. Westfield 1 team gained confidence and improved their skills and were rewarded with a win in their final match of the day. Westfield A team, won 4 of their matches with very high scores and then narrowly lost their final match by 5 points, coming 2nd overall.

However, the icing on the cake was the children being rewarded with the School Games Values Trophy; this award was given by the sports leader and adults throughout the day for the school who showed the best teamwork, respect, honesty, passion, determination, and self- belief during the matches.
