## Sports Report

After 2 weeks of very changeable weather, we were very lucky that the Year 6 boys cricket tournament was able to take place on Tuesday at Market Deeping Cricket Club. Most of our players had shown an interest in cricket during PE lessons, with some coming to our after-school club.

We took 2 teams to play in this local inter school competition. This year the event had 3 groups consisting of 3 teams, all playing a round robin in the morning to determine who they played in the afternoon matches. Westfield Greens won all their matches in the morning and for their final match they faced a tough team from Market Deeping County Primary School. Despite their best efforts and great teamwork, supporting each other from the sidelines, they came home with a very respectable 2<sup>nd</sup> place overall. Westfield Blues had very tough opening matches, they continued to work hard as a team working on their bowling and fielding and getting wickets. They didn't give up and played some great cricket despite not winning their matches. Well done to all our pupils who were praised by the event organiser for showing great spirit/teamwork throughout the event.

Yesterday it was the Year 5's turn to represent Westfield at a unique world Cup football competition, organised by Y.D.P, held at Elsea Park Astro Turf. Despite the heavy rain, the event went ahead, all our pupils showed such teamwork, spirit and resilience to plough on through in very tough conditions. We had two teams, Senegal and Tunisa. The boys received match T-shirts to play in which they have kept as a reminder of the day. Both teams played 4 matches in the group stages. At the end of the group stages the top teams were put into 3 different cups, the gold cup, the silver cup and the bronze cup. Both Westfield teams were in the silver cup competition. The boys were excited to have the prospect of playing each other. Tunisa lost very narrowly in their matches and came 5<sup>th</sup> overall; it really was a day of tight margins. Whilst Senegal went on a winning streak, winning the silver cup with a clean sheet and some well-placed goals. Well done to all the pupils the competition was of an extremely high standard, and they should all be incredibly proud of themselves.
