On Thursday, eight 8 Year 5 pupils travelled to Woodhall Spa Cricket Club to represent Southeast Lincolnshire at the cricket county finals.

There were 8 teams playing in two pools in the morning, with the two top teams going through to the semi-finals.

Winning 2 of our 3 matches put us 2nd in the group. We then played New Waltham who had gone unbeaten in their group matches. We started strongly in bat and continued to keep the pressure on, fielding very strongly, resulting in a well-deserved and convincing win 72 to 58!

In the final we faced Tower Road who we had previously lost to in the group matches. This was to be a very tight match as we continued to grow in confidence; however, a run of wickets very near the end allowed Tower Road to clinch the victory in the last 2 overs, winning by 16.

Well done to all the pupils who can now proudly say we are 2nd in the county at school's cricket. A huge thank you to all the parents who helped with transport and supported us on the day. And to our mascot 'Chippy the Pied Wagtail' for giving us courage and determination.
