Important Safety Guidance for Parents

SNAPCHAT

Snapchat has launched a new update for their social media app with a new 'Meet Up' feature. This feature located within the 'SnapMap' section of the app allows for people to view your location and get precise directions to you via Google or Apple maps without any warning or notifications.

The guidance for parents is to regularly check your children's accounts to ensure the points below are followed:

- Ensure they only have friends added to their account
- Their account is restricted with the correct settings
- Their snap map location is set to 'Only Me'

We have heard a small number of concerns expressed around 'Huggy Wuggy'. While this appears cartoon like, elements of it promotes violence and killing. Please be very vigilant with children using computers/laptops/mobile phones and ensure you are monitoring what your children access.
