This week we took part in the first sports events of the academic year. # Fixed Penalty Notice Letter

I informed parents at the curriculum evenings in July that our attendance procedures were changing and that all parents would be receiving a letter regarding this when the new term commenced in September. The letter has been shared with all parents this week via Parentmail and we are in the process of sharing paper copies of the letter a year group at a time.

In line with our school Attendance Policy and advice from Lincolnshire County Council, we are required to send out this information letter as formal notice that if a child's absence meets the fining criteria that the school will be referring this to Lincolnshire County Council. As Lincolnshire County Council will be acting on our behalf with regards to this, we are unable to fine parents unless they have received this warning notice letter.

Please do not be alarmed by the title of the letter. We have to issue parents with this letter which is for information only and this will be re-issued every two years.
