Sports Report

This week, it was the Year 6 girls football teams turn to represent Westfield at our local annual school games competition. We were also the first teams to wear the new sports kit which has been funded by Friends of Westfield and sponsored very kindly by Compare the Market - thank you for supporting us.

So, off we went to Spalding High School, to compete against 5 other schools in a round robin event. The day started with warm up drills led by their sports leaders. We all played 6 matches, with 3 points for a win, 1 for a draw and 0 for a loss to compete for a place in the Level 3 county competition in the Spring. Both teams played well - Westfield Reds won their first match, which was a great confidence boost, especially as for most of the team it was their first experience of playing in a competitive match. They then played Westfield Blues and kept the score to a very respectable 2-0, gaining confidence and displaying great teamwork and passion. Overall, they won 2, lost 3 and drew against Baston to come 4th overall. Westfield Reds, went on to win 5 out of 6 matches comfortably, drawing their 6th match against Linchfield. It was so close as the results were read out as both Westfield Reds and Linchfield had won 5 out of 6 matches, drawn against each other, and neither team conceded any goals throughout the competition. The positions for 1st and 2nd were decided by goal difference; this meant that Linchfield came 1st overall as they had scored a total of 14 goals to our 13!

The girls in both teams put in such a lot of effort and should be very proud of their conduct throughout the day, great football, tremendous teamwork and huge amounts of respect and maturity were displayed. Well done to all involved and to Mrs Hibbins and Mrs Walker for your sideline support.
