A Date with Dan: Free TEAMS Online Safety Q&A for Parents/Guardians, 7<sup>th</sup> December 6-7pm. Over two thirds of pupils surveyed in the LSCP 2021 Keeping Safe Online Survey indicated that their parents didn't know everything about their online activities. The survey also showed when parents talked openly to their children about their activity online, those pupils were less likely to experience cyberbullying and more likely to access support.
