Sports Report from Mrs Anderson

This week it was the turn of the Year 6 boys to represent the school at the School Games inter-school football competition, which was held at Spalding Academy. This event is always very competitive, as it leads on to a level 3 competition for the winners.

We took two teams; the teams were split into three groups who all played each other in a round robin in the morning. From the results of this, the teams were then placed into new groups in the afternoon to play another round of matches to determine the overall places. Westfield Reds had a tough start to the day; in fact, their first match was against Market Deeping, the winners of the tournament, losing 6-1. They then lost to Bourne Abbey, which meant they went on to play all the other 3^{rd} place teams in the afternoon. Parents' Evenings

Half Term Break & Winter Uniform

A reminder that the school closes next Thursday for the half term break (Friday is a training day) and the new term begins on Monday 3rd November. When we return, we would ask that all children are in winter uniform - no polo shirts (except children in Reception classes) or summer dresses please. Children should wear their white shirts and ties (we know that some girls prefer to wear revere collared blouses). Grey trousers, grey skirts or grey trousers and navy or grey tights (not black).

Please ensure children wear suitable school shoes and not trainers, sandals or boots during the winter months. We value the support of our parents for our school uniform policy. Remember, there is plenty of uniform in the swap shack and the Friends of the school sell uniform at drastically reduced rates.

REMINDER - Clubs

A reminder that there are no school led clubs next week due to parents' evenings taking place - this includes cross country. External clubs will continue as normal. Children who have attended school led clubs this term will continue with these after the half term break - the final week for clubs is week commencing Monday 1st December - please make a note of this on your calendar. If your child previously had permission to walk home after a club, they must be collected, from Monday 3rd November, as the clocks will have changed when we return from the break, leading to darker nights. School Lunches

A reminder that Tuesday 21st October is the deadline for ordering meals for the first week back. All of the weekly menus for next term are now available on the meal's website. A copy of the menu and any upcoming 'Theme Days' for next term has been sent out by MCAS and added to the school website. Please ensure all orders are placed by the deadline as the kitchen is unable to provide food where no order has been placed.

IMPORTANT - Free School Meals

Just a reminder - If you have a child in Years 3-6 and they are entitled to benefit-related Free School Meals, please remember to order lunches for them on the Meals website. The website allows you to order for a whole term, track your orders and view menus ahead of time. Please note the deadline for meal orders is midnight on the Tuesday prior to the week you are ordering for; the school has no flexibility to work beyond this. After this deadline, the menus for that week will be taken down and you will be unable to order meals for that period. The school will not order lunches for Free School Meal children in KS2. It is the responsibility of the parents to either order a lunch or provide a pack up.

IMPORTANT - Spy Dog Book series QR code/URL link

We have been advised that certain editions of the Spy Dog book series by Andrew Cope containing QR codes or URLs leading to a companion website that were originally safe, have recently been compromised. The domain linked to the QR code is now controlled by a third party hosting inappropriate adult content that is not affiliated with the author or publisher. Consequently, the publisher Puffin and author Andrew Cope have halted sales and distribution of these books and are working to have the site removed through legal channels. Parents/Carers should:

- Immediately prevent children from accessing the QR code or website.
- Remove any Spy Dog, Spy Cat, or Spy Pups books containing the QR code from home bookshelves temporarily or ensure the QR code is not accessible or is completely removed from the book, if the child is currently reading the book.
- Inform their children not to visit the linked website as it contains inappropriate content.

- Follow any further guidance or updates from schools or the publisher regarding the situation.
- Consider contacting schools or libraries to check if copies have been withdrawn.
- Engage in conversations with their children about the importance of safe internet use and reporting if they accidentally visit unsuitable sites.
