Reading & Quiet Social Space

The area that has previously been used for digging is having a complete facelift. The area will be levelled and finished with artificial turf and a small picket fence. There will be a small reading shed, filled with books and bean bags for the children to access.

We are having a large sandpit dug out at the side of the new Year 5 block too - with the dug-out dirt/spoil being used to create feature mounds. We will be working closely alongside FOW to find ways to fundraise to purchase the sand to fill it.
