Please find details of the WTT training offer for 2025 2026.

We have been listening to the messages from our SENCOs, have expanded our offer with new AET modules and WTT training sessions and made some changes on how training can be accessed this year. This offer now includes:

- Live online training via Teams for specific AET modules and WTT training
- Live face to face training on specific themes
- Pre-recorded training- accessible via request, starting from November 2025- see tables at bottom of this document.
- Blended training which will have a pre-recorded session to watch and then a live online follow up for discussion, activities or Q&A.
