















Year 2

Welcome back to a new year here at Westfield.

We would like to take this opportunity to tell you a little about what is coming up in Year 6. As a school, we are currently focusing on improving progress in Reading, Writing, Maths and building resilience as part of our whole 'School Improvement Plan'.

Subject	Term 1	Term 2
PSHE 	<u>Being Me</u> <p>The children will discuss their hopes and fears for the year ahead - they will talk about feeling worried and recognising when they should ask for help and who to ask. They will talk about rights and responsibilities, how to work collaboratively, how to listen to each other and how to make their classroom a safe and fair place. The children will talk about choices and the consequences of making different choices.</p>	<u>Celebrating Difference</u> <p>The children will talk about gender stereotypes and that boys and girls can have differences and similarities and that is ok. They will talk about children being bullied because they are different, that this shouldn't happen and how to support a classmate who is being bullied. The children will talk about feelings associated with bullying and how and where to get help. They will talk about similarities and differences and that it is ok for friends to have differences without it affecting their friendship.</p>
English 	<p>Active English - nouns, verbs & adjectives - identifying these in given texts & using them in our own sentences. Improving given sentences using the above. Creating simple sentences using capital letters and full stops accurately. Checking for errors to improve our own work. Introduction of adverbs, including adverbs of time to start sentences and the use of adverbs to describe verbs.</p>	
	<p>The Hodgeheg - We will learn about Road Safety through reading The Hodgeheg. We will use our knowledge of adjectives, verbs and nouns to write a setting description and a diary entry. The children will begin learning to read and spell the Year 2 Common Exception words.</p>	<p>The Queen's Nose - The children will use adjectives, expanded noun phrases, adverbs and a range of conjunctions to write a short narrative based on the story. The children will also look at a range of poetry and will be performing this within their classes.</p>
Maths 	<p>Place Value - partitioning 2-digit numbers in tens and ones, comparing and ordering numbers to 100. Addition and subtraction - mental and written methods. To be able to estimate numbers and place them on a blank number line.</p> <p>We will be practising the x10 multiplication table - please help with this at home.</p>	<p>Addition and subtraction written methods. Shape - recognising 2d and 3d shapes and counting sides and vertices. Sorting 2d and 3d shapes and recognising lines of symmetry in shapes.</p>
Science 	<p>Living things and their habitats - food chains, living or non-living things, classifying information. Mini-beast hunt.</p>	<p>Animals including humans - To know the basic needs of animals including food, water, shelter and air. The importance of exercise, hygiene and a balanced diet. The human timeline.</p>

Computing 	Year 2 will be continuing their coding journey from Year 1. Learning how to write programmes, debug programmes and creating their own programmes linked to our Habitats topic.	
D&T 		Making a pasta dish The children will design a dish, create and evaluate their result. The children will practise their cutting and chopping skills using a knife.
Art 	Drawing How to create tone and texture using pencil and charcoal. To sketch facial features accurately.	
Geography 	How can we stay safe in Bourne? Exploring our local area. Walk around Bourne. Looking at aerial maps. Map symbols and creating a key. Compass points - North, East, South West.	
History 		Is Bourne a historical town? Changes beyond living memory.
PE 	Indoor PE - Gymnastics - linking Outdoor PE - Games - rackets, bats and balls.	Indoor PE - Dance Explorers Outdoor PE - Games - dodging
RE 	Christianity What did Jesus teach?	Christianity A gift from God.
Music 	Singing familiar songs, controlling the pitch and volume of the voice. Warming up exercises, keeping to a steady beat. Learning to use simple percussion instruments.
