PSHE	Dreams and Goals Children will learn about setting goals for themselves and staying motivated even when tasks are hard. They will do this through a garden design project.	Healthy Me Children will learn about staying physically healthy by balancing energy intake with exercise. They will learn about the emergency services and think about different safe and unsafe situations. They will begin to learn about drugs and start to understand the difference between safe prescribed drugs and dangerous drugs.

Maths	Multiplication and Division  Consolidating all the times tables learned so far (2x, 5x, 10x, 3x, 4x, 8x); Formal written methods for multiplication and division.  Length and Perimeter  We will be measuring in metres, centimetres, millimetres and learning to find equivalent measurements in each unit. We will be adding and subtracting lengths and will use this to learn about and calculate perimeters.  Fractions  We will be looking at unit and non-unit fractions. We will be comparing and ordering fractions and looking at them on a number line.	
Science	Rocks and Soils  Children will be learning about the different types of rocks, rock formation and fossil formation.  Children will be investigating the absorbency of different rocks and consider their suitability for purpose. Computing	Purple Mash - Touch typing, branching databases and simulations  We will be continuing our learning on Purple Mash. Children will be learning about how to be safe online, how to create and use branching databases and simulations within  Purple Mash.
