Logo - Pupils will learn common commands and constructs of the Logo programming language. They will also develop their ability to compose algorithms for drawing mathematical structures and turning these into Logo code.
D&T/Art	Pupils will be exploring the artist Maurice Sendak to developing their pencil skills. They will be exploring tone and texture with Max Ernst's frottage technique. Pupils will also be looking at both William Grill and Charlie Mackesy and creating artwork in the style of both of these artists.	Pupils will be designing and constructing a fully functioning torch. Pupils will have to investigate and evaluate the effectiveness of current torches on the market. They will then use this to inform their own designs.

Family - introduce vocabulary for family members, focusing on gender and use of appropriate article Do you have a brother or sister?


