









Year 5

Welcome back to 2023 at Westfield.

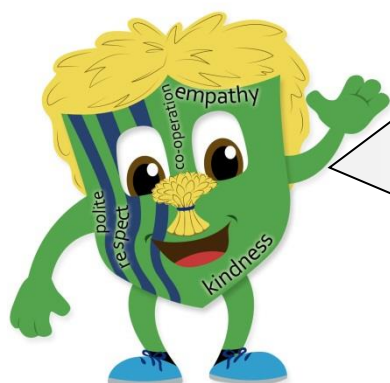
