










# Year 5

<b>PSHE</b> 	<b>Dreams and Goals</b> The children will consider jobs and careers, dreams and aspirations and how to work towards fulfilling these. <b>Science</b> 	<b>Earth and Space</b> The pupils will learn about the Earth's movement in space, why we have day and night, the phases of the moon and how technology has evolved in space.	<b>Forces</b> The pupils will learn about the different types of forces, the effects of air resistance and friction. They will explore different mechanisms using levers, pulleys and gears.
<b>Computing</b> 	<b>Spreadsheets</b> Pupils will learn how to use IT to organise information. Pupils will learn how convert measurements and to use spreadsheets to model real-life problems using standard formula.	<b>Data Bases</b> Pupils will be introduced to databases and learn about their importance in organising information for rapid search.

<b>Art</b> 	<b>Printing: Collagraph Vases</b> <i>Glen Alps</i> Building a printing plate, using repeated patterns, focusing on shape and line. Analysing a piece of art.	<b>Digital Art: Portraits</b> <i>Florian Nicoelle</i> Multi-media portrait on canvas.

<b>Geography</b> 		
<b>History</b> 	<b>How is Ancient Greece impacted on present day culture and laws?</b> Pupils will draw upon artefacts and research to understand the culture and lives of those living in Ancient Greece, the founders of democracy.	<b>How did events in Tudor England lead to change?</b> Pupils will learn about the lives of Tudors, the laws and how Henry VIII's actions changed the Church.
<b>PE</b> 	<b>Indoor PE</b> Greek Dance - This unit develops pupil's understanding by using motifs, building up individual, paired and ensemble work. <b>Outdoor PE</b> Hockey	<b>Indoor PE</b> Strength and fitness- Pupil will learn about the importance of staying fit and healthy. The pupils will participate in a variety of strength circuits. <b>Outdoor PE</b> Tennis
<b>RE</b> 	<b>Hinduism</b> <i>How can Brahman be everywhere and in everything?</i> The children will look at how Hindus believe there is a part of Brahman in everything and everyone. They will also explore and research other Hindu gods and goddesses.	<b>Christianity</b> <i>How significant is it for Christians to believe God intended Jesus to die?</i> The pupils will look at the events of Holy Week (the week leading up to the death and resurrection of Jesus) to investigate the cause and effects of these events
<b>Music</b> 	<b>Digital Music</b> The pupils will learn about hip-hop and the culture surrounding it. The pupils will use GarageBand to create their own songs and write their own lyrics.	<b>Music Theory- Keyboards</b> The pupils will learn about chords (major and minor), notation and basic music theory.
