 - A date will be arranged for them to be displayed and billboards carried at the beginning and end of the school day.
 - The posters are to explain the damage done by engines running outside of the school, 'Stop Pollution - switch off your engine'
- Joanne says 'Don't be under illusion, stop pollution'... anything that gets the message across about how we all need to work together to keep pollution low, particularly around the school. Perhaps also asking "Is it necessary to drive? Leave the car at home!"
 - Keep our air cleaner - switch off your engines.
